### **Scams**

06.15 The victim reported that his daughter sent him an email about a type of car that he enjoys and he clicked on a sidebar which opened a pop-up that stated he had to call apple and provided a phone number. He spoke with a female who gave the name Janet and provided the ID number AB40257. The female informed him that his computer had been used for child pornography and money laundering and he would have to talk to someone from the Federal Government. He was then transferred to a male who gave the name Noel Rosengart, who is a legitimate employee of the FTC. The male then gave him an "FTC number" of 923846LT-2026 and the victim gave him his SSN and a picture of his driver's license. Noel instructed the victim to go to Top Line Financial Credit Union in Coon Rapids and withdraw \$30,000 and that an individual would meet him in the parking lot and give him a passcode to ensure he knew it was the right person. At this point the victim stated he realized this was a scam and he stopped talking to the male.

### **Arrests**

06.13 133 Ave/Crosstown Blvd NW – Traffic; a deputy stopped a driver for not having a front plate. She was identified and when asked her for her license and insurance, she was unable to provide insurance and handed me an ID card. After running her, the deputy found she was revoked. She had been cited on 02/21/2026, 11/28/2025, 09/09/2025 for not being able to provide proof of insurance. On all 3 of those citations, she failed to appear in court. Due to her not appearing for her citations and believing she would continue to drive without proof of insurance, her vehicle was towed. She was cited for driving after revocation along with not having proof of insurance.

06.13 Bunker Lake/140 Ave NW – DWI 4<sup>th</sup> degree; a deputy stopped a driver for having expired tabs. When the deputy turned on his lights, the driver slammed on his brakes and stopped in the middle of the road. The deputy made contact and smelled marijuana. The driver advised he smoked a couple hours earlier. Field sobriety tests were failed. A warrant for blood was obtained. Formal charges pending blood results.

06.13 Round Lake/140 Ave NW – DWI 2<sup>nd</sup> degree; deputies were called to a domestic where a female left the residence with her children and she was possibly impaired. A deputy located the vehicle in the area and stopped it. The deputy smelled alcohol on the woman and there were three children in the vehicle. None of the children were probably secured in the vehicle. Field sobriety tests were failed, she was arrested. .208 Charges were elevated due to children being in the vehicle.

06.15 20xx Bunker Lake Blvd NW – Shoplifting; a deputy responded to three juveniles shoplifting. They were putting items in their backpacks. A deputy arrived and saw them exiting the store and stopped them. They had stolen over \$1400 in items. They were detained and their parents were contacted. All three were arrested.

06.16 Bunker Lake/Round Lake Blvd NW – DWI 4<sup>th</sup> degree; a deputy stopped a driver for drifting between lanes, almost hitting the deputy's vehicle. When stopped the driver stated his license was expired. The driver appeared impaired. When asked he stated he had one drink. Field sobriety tests were failed and he was arrested. .132

After investigating, the BF was going to be arrested. It was believed he was hiding in a neighbor's detached garage. A warrant was obtained to enter the garage but the male wasn't in there. A warrant for his arrest was obtained and a KOPS alert was placed on him.

06.16 182xx Alamo St NE – Warrant Arrest; a deputy learned a juvenile male with a warrant was at the location. He arrived and the male was arrested and brought to Lino Lake Juvenile Detention.

The deputy asked when he last used and he said "yesterday" he used meth. Meth was found in the center console. A warrant for a blood draw was obtained. He was arrested.

### **Arrests**

06.13 77xx Fawn Lake Dr NE – Felony Domestic Assault; deputies responded to a physical domestic between a group who gathered for a bonfire and drinks. The suspect fled before deputies arrived. A drone and K9 were used. Eventually the drone located the male hiding in the garage. He was arrested. Charges were elevated due to three prior assault convictions.

06.15 230xx E Martin Lake Dr NE – Domestic Assault; deputies responded to a physical assault between a husband and wife. After investigating, the husband was arrested.

06.17 217xx Viking Blvd NW – Domestic Assault; deputies responded to a physical assault between a boyfriend/girlfriend. The GF left in fear. Deputies spoke with her and gathered evidence. They went to the location of the assault to arrest the BF. He would not respond. A warrant was obtained to enter the home. The male came out yelling at deputies. He was arrested.

06.14 Lake George – Water Rescue; a deputy was dispatched to a water rescue in the lake. A Kayaker tipped over and needed assistance. Deputy Jacobson went to the boat launch and spoke to a boater who was willing to help him find the kayaker. They found the kayaker holding onto another person's kayak. Neither party was wearing a life jacket. With the help of the volunteer boater, they were able to pull the victim into the boat. They attached the kayak onto a rope and towed the boat to shore. The victim was not injured and declined medical attention.

06.15 21400 Block Rum River Blvd NW – DWI 4<sup>th</sup> degree; a deputy responded to a single vehicle crash. The woman involved was trying to leave the scene. The deputy suspected she was impaired by either drugs or alcohol. She refused to test and kept rambling. She mentioned smoking marijuana, then said she hadn't and prescription medication was found in the vehicle. A warrant for blood was obtained; charges are pending the results.

06.16 600 Block Sims Rd NW – Flee on Foot; a deputy attempted to stop a male on a bike because it was 1 am and he had no lights or reflectors on the bike. The male refused to stop and kept biking. Another deputy came to assist, and the male hopped off his bike and fled. He was eventually caught. He was arrested. Meth was found on him.
