ORDINANCE NO. 26-XX

AN ORDINANCE CLARIFYING THE LEGAL DESCRIPTION CONTAINED IN ORDINANCE NO. 26-08 AND CONFIRMING THE CITY COUNCIL'S ORIGINAL REZONING INTENT

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2026, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 26-08 rezoning certain property within the City of Ham Lake from Rural Single Family Residential (R-A) to Single Family Residential (R-1); and

WHEREAS, the legal description included in Ordinance No. 26-08 inadvertently contained the legal description of an easement over an adjacent parcel that was not intended to be rezoned; and

WHEREAS, the inclusion of the easement description was a scrivener's error; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to clarify the record and confirm its original intent;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council hereby clarifies that Ordinance No. 26-08 was intended to rezone only the following property:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the zoning classification established by Ordinance No. 26-08 applies only to Parcel A and does not apply to any adjacent parcel or easement area referenced in the ordinance legal description.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any references within Ordinance No. 26-08 to easements over adjacent parcels are surplus language, were included in error, and were not intended to alter or affect the zoning classification of any other property.

Subject: Cannabis Registration Application

Introduction/Discussion: The City of Ham Lake received a completed cannabis registration application on July 7, 2026 from Rami Abu Hamra (“Applicant”) to operate a retail cannabis dispensary at 13654 Highway 65. The Applicant has obtained license approval from the State of Minnesota through the Office of Cannabis Management (“OCM”). The existing commercial site is zoned Commercial Development I (CD-1). A retail cannabis dispensary is an approved use within the zoning district. The property is located outside of the prohibited cannabis retail region that requires at least 1,000 feet from any school and at least 500 feet away from all other daycares, parks, treatment facilities, and churches. The applicant has obtained a building permit to remodel the interior of the existing building and that has been approved by the Building and Zoning Official with various requirements.

Recommendation: I recommend the approval of the Cannabis Registration Application with the following conditions:

1. A Certificate of Occupancy and a city registration for cannabis retail will only be issued once the Building and Zoning Official has done a final inspection of the property and the Applicant has met all conditions of the building permit.
2. No Cannabis may be sold at the premises until both documents listed above are issued to the applicant.
3. Meeting all other City, County and State requirements.

1. **Engage with local governments.** Begin discussions with your local government early to understand and meet all local requirements, including zoning, any necessary conditional use permits, and retail registration (if applicable). You must secure a physical location that complies with local zoning ordinances and update your application documents showing you are compliant with all local requirements. You are strongly encouraged to do this at the earliest stage possible before you invest in any location.
2. **Submit final documents.** Preliminarily approved applicants will submit final application materials to OCM when they can demonstrate compliance with all applicable rules. The materials include details about the site location, final operational documentation, and documentation of any ownership changes, and are referred to as final plans of record. 3. Once you have completed and submitted the online forms, you will receive PDFs of your final plans of record via email that must be uploaded to the Office of Cannabis Management (OCM) through Accela. OCM will forward your application to the local government indicated on your application.
4. **Local government zoning compliance certification.** Local governments have 30 days to certify that your application complies with zoning and land use ordinances. Important: be sure to engage early with your local government so that you understand their timelines and process for local zoning compliance certification. OCM recommends that preliminarily approved applicants wait until

all the required items for local approval have been met with their local government before they submit their site registration. Additionally, be sure to remain in close communication with the local government to ensure that they are prepared to review the application. Please review the guidance for local governments regarding zoning compliance certification located here: <https://mn.gov/ocm/local-governments/localgovs.jsp> for awareness on what local governments will be required to complete for this stage.
